



Annual Report for 2018

Heartland Center for Behavioral Change (HCBC) continues our commitment to maintaining full compliance with the requirements of the Prison Elimination Act of 2003. In accordance with the PREA standards, HCBC has a zero tolerance policy for all forms of resident sexual abuse and harassment. While residing at Heartland Center for Behavioral Change, residents have the right to be free from sexual abuse, sexual harassment and retaliation.

Progress in 2018:

Heartland Center for Behavioral Change passed the PREA compliance audit.

In 2018, HCBC received and investigated 11 allegations involving resident sexual abuse and harassment. The chart below depicts the findings of the 11 cases by incident types.
